Dysphagia (*swallowing problem*) occurs in 50-60% of stroke patients and in 40-52% of rehabilitation patients. Its presence can result in aspiration pneumonia, malnutrition and/or death. Stroke patients must be screened for dysphagia within 24 hours of hospital admission.
